



RECIPE: Hot Honey Chicken Sliders with Jalapeno Slaw

3 c cooked shredded chicken (rotisserie works great) $\frac{1}{2}$ c hot honey (or mix $\frac{1}{2}$ c honey + 1-2 t hot sauce) 12 slider buns or Hawaiian rolls 1 ½ c shredded coleslaw mix 1/4 c mayonnaise 1 T apple cider vinegar 1 T finely diced pickled jalapenos Salt and pepper to taste Butter for toasting rolls



Mix shredded chicken with hot honey in a bowl until fully coated. In a separate bowl, combine coleslaw mix, mayo, vinegar, jalapenos, salt, and pepper. Chill until ready to serve. Lightly butter and toast slider buns. Pile hot honey chicken on bottom bun, top with jalapeno slaw, and finish with top bun.

These are perfect for tailgating tables or halftime snacking.

Especially in the fall, these pieces add rich warmth to our tables and decor. But what can you do with those odds-and-ends pieces you've collected and stored in a cabinet?



A Fresh Canvas for Cleveland: Dye Creek Fine Arts Festival Debuts This October

RECIPE: Apple Spice Cake

½ stick unsalted butter 3 eggs 1 c sour cream 1 package Raven's Original Mulling Spice (set aside 1 T for glaze) 1 ½ c peeled and diced crisp apples (Granny Smith) 2 T half and half




