




## Letter from the Publishers

## RECIPE: Million Dollar Spaghetti

1 lb spaghetti noodles 1 lb ground beef 3 T dried minced onion 2 cloves garlic, minced ½ t salt • ½ t pepper 6 c marinara sauce, divided 8 oz cream cheese, softened 3 c mozzarella cheese, shredded, divided

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cook spaghetti noodles according to package. While the noodles are cooking, brown ground beef with the dried onions, garlic, salt and pepper on high. Drain liquid and mix in one cup of marinara sauce. Combine cooked spaghetti with the remaining 5 cups of marinara sauce. Mix cream cheese and 2 cups of mozzarella cheese in a bowl. Add half the pasta and sauce mixture to the bottom of a 9x13 inch pan. Add the cream cheese mixture. Top with remaining pasta/sauce mixture. Add the meat/sauce mixture on top of the pasta and top with remaining cup of mozzarella cheese. Cover and bake for 30 minutes. Uncover and bake for an additional 10 minutes until cheese is melted. Let cool for 5-10 minutes, then cut into squares to serve.



6 large tart apples, cored, sliced, can peel 1 c granulated sugar 1/4 c light brown sugar, packed 1 T cinnamon 1/8 t nutmeg 3 T cornstarch 4 T butter, sliced

Put all ingredients except butter into crockpot. Stir well, coating all apple slices, and place butter slices on top. Cook on high 1.5 - 2 hours or low 3.5 - 4, stirring once halfway through.



## Tennessee Military Collectors Association Fall Show: Nov. 28 & 29

antique owners will tell you military facts are among the most highly sought-after items in their booths and showcases. don't have enough of them-and when we do have them, they just don't stay long," one veteran dealer says. "Relics from all time periods and countries appeal to many customers who have an interest in history or are fascinated by the souvenirs soldiers brought home."

Where do dealers find these rare treasures? Some scour vard and estate sales, while others spend hours browsing online. But the single best opportunity to find all types of military relics is at a Tennessee Military Collectors Association (TMCA) Show, always conducted Thanksgiving and Easter weekends in Middle Tennessee. The next TMCA show is set for November 28 and 29, 2025, at the Cool Springs Marriott in Williamson County.

TMCA President Jimmy Howell calls the event a "multi-opportunity" experience where visitors "can buy or sell military relics, obtain information and appraisals, or just enjoy being in a museum-type atmosphere."

"TMCA was founded fifty years ago as a non-profit organization to honor veterans, preserve military artifacts and provide opportunities for people to see or collect these items," Howell says. "Our

Fall Show will be open to the public from noon to 6pm Friday, November 28, and 8am to 3pm Saturday, November 29, at the Cool Springs Marriott in Williamson County, Admission is free for Junior ROTC and Scout members in uniform, children under 15 (with a parent) and active-duty military, police and fire department members. For all others, admission is \$5."

Thousands of historic items will be on display, for sale or for trade at the show, including uniforms, medals, badges, photos, swords, daggers, vintage military weapons, flags, helmets, insignia, radios, cameras, binoculars, books, paper artifacts, home front collectibles and more. Weather permitting, WW II-era military vehicles may also be on display in the Marriott parking lot. (Modern weapons are not permitted to be sold or brought into the show.)

"We will fill three Cool Springs Marriott ballrooms with more than 400 tables featuring military artifacts from many nations and time periods," Howell says. "This will be a family-friendly event where guests can start or expand a collection of militaria with items in all price ranges, talk with militaria experts or simply enjoy seeing and touching military pieces. We will also have multiple drawings to give away TMCA wearables."

Howell adds that many visitors bring military items they have inherited from a relative or friend and want more information about. "Fortunately," he says, "we have many nationally respected subject matter experts who can provide valuable details about the purpose of an item and how, when and where it may have been used. It is a pleasure for us to provide historical background information and offer advice on how to preserve important relics."

The Cool Springs Marriott is located at 700 Cool Springs Blvd., Franklin, approximately 10 minutes from Nashville. Parking is free. Each year, TMCA uses show proceeds and member donations to support Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps programs at Middle Tennessee schools, as well as veterans' initiatives, including recent gifts to Operation Stand Down Tennessee and Honor Flight of Middle Tennessee.

What started with 40 dealers has now grown to 93 strong, each bringing





## FOR THE LOVE OF RELISH DISHES

The holiday season has arrived, and for most of us that means parties featuring all kinds of foods. Many of them will feature a vegetable tray-raw crudités or perhaps pickled vegetables... aka, "relishes." Of course, these nibbles can be piled on a board, a platter or a plate, but what if you had a special dish (or several dishes) just for them?

The origins of relishes and relish dishes aren't a chicken-and-egg question: the relishes definitely came first and the specialized dishes came later-and they've evolved a bit over time.

First, let's define our terminology. A relish is a preserve of finely chopped vegetables or fruit (or both) pickled in a vinegar sauce. The oldest known relish originated in India (think chutney), dating back at least 1,500 years. By the 1700s, Europeans had developed a fondness for chutneys and gave these pickled foods a new name. The term "relish" is Old French and loosely translated means "something remaining," referring to a lingering, enjoyable taste or flavor.

In the 1800s, well-to-do hostesses showed off their pickled foods in "castors"-glass jars fitted into metal holders that allowed pickled vegetables to be displayed and served, typically with special forks or tongs. Around the same time, celery vases became fashionable, holding stalks of the exotic vegetable as edible centerpieces, signaling a family's wealth and good taste to offer such an expensive, perishable vegetable on their table. A diagram from the March 1859 issue of Godey's Lady's Book shows the place of honor reserved for the celery vase and pickle castor.

During this era, relishes of chopped mixed vegetables became a popular way to preserve and serve garden surplus. Here in the South, chowchow is still a popular condiment with a sweet/ tangy flavor. In 1888, the Heinz Company introduced "piccalilli," a sour relish, but it was never as popular as the sweet relish they introduced the following year. Originally called "India Relish," today it's known simply as "pickle relish" and you'll find it next to the ketchup and mustard dispensers wherever hot dogs are sold.

Also during this same time period, pressed glass entered the scene as a new trend for tableware, with large sets of matching patterns allowing even modest households to create a coordinated buffet or table service for entertaining. Known today as Early American Pressed Glass (or EAPG), these dishes started out clear with simple geometric patterns. Over time, colored glass and more fanciful designs were added. Around the same time, bright colorful dishes such as Fiestaware rose in popularity among the middle class.





In the early 1900s,


we broadened the term "relish dish" to include a wide assortment of pickled and fresh vegetables, and by the 1930s, "relish dishes" were offered in various shapes including round shallow bowls as well as plates and platters. Divided relish dishes gave hostesses the ability to create a dizzying array of delicacies while keeping their flavors from mingling. Fiestaware's divided relish tray with interchangeable compartments is now a muchsought-after item among collectors; don't be surprised to find them offered for \$500-\$1,000 depending on condition and color.

America's love of piquant spreads led to the rise in popularity of relish trays served at steakhouses and supper clubs in the 1930s and '40s, especially in the upper Midwest. Diners had an assortment of tasty appetizers to nosh on while waiting on their entrées. The popularity of relish tray dishes persisted through the 1970s when the food landscape was altered by the rise of frozen and processed foods. (We fully support bringing back the fancy relish tray along with dressing up for an evening out at a supper club with a floor

show and orchestra.)

So what makes the perfect relish tray? Opinions vary, but here are the four main components that comprise a traditional relish tray:

- 1. Pickled vegetables are the main stars: olives, pickled baby corn and of course pickles-tiny gherkins or other pickled cucumbers are always solid choices, but for variety, consider adding pickled mushrooms, onions or beets.
- 2. Fresh vegetables are a matter of personal taste, but typical options include green onions, carrots, broccoli, radishes and celery as mainstays.
  - 3. Spreads and dips are also traditional-from duck or chicken liver pâté to beer cheese or vinaigrettes with fresh minced herbs. More modern renditions may include spinach dip, ranch or bleu cheese dressing.
  - 4. Crackers, small rye bread slices, pretzels or pita chips offer a nice crunchy complement to the rest of the ingredients.



As with most throwback vintage items, you'll find antique castors, celery vases and divided relish trays in all shapes and sizes at thrift stores, estate sales and antique shops. Look for dishes that will complement your other serving pieces—or that just speak to you and say, "Take me home and make me pretty." Look them over for chips, nicks and cracks before buying,

especially if you plan to use them.

#### Caring for Pressed Glass Dishes

Hand washing and drying are important for all vintage glassware. Between uses, store pieces in a cabinet or hutch where they are protected from direct sunlight and the risk of breaking. But do use them—as often as possible, especially during the holiday season.

#### Other Uses for Divided Relish Dishes

Relish trays aren't limited to the dining room. The compartments make excellent organizers for small desk items as well as jewelry trays, makeup organizers on a vanity or as an under-tray for soap dispensers. So whether you use yours for serving an appetizer course of pickled foods to your guests or for more mundane tasks, we hope you'll find a way to incorporate them into your daily life.





# What's The Buzz About Honey Bees?

ovember brings the beginning of cold temperatures. Honeybees are all about survival of the colony and protecting their queen, because without the queen, the colony will die. During late fall and winter, there are no resources coming in such as pollen or nectar, so the bees prepare to survive the winter on what they've stored in their comb.

#### Fun Honeybee Fall and Winter Facts

In October the bees have already begun kicking out the drones! Drones are male bees. They don't have jobs in the winter like their sisters, known as worker bees. As the bees settle in for winter, the drones become unnecessary mouths to feed, so they are evicted and left to live the remainder of their days outside the hive. Not to worry—in the spring, the queen will lay new drone eggs. She determines the sex of every bee based on the needs of the colony that season.

Goldenrod is a crucial resource for all pollinators in November. Fall provides very few blooming plants after a long summer dearth, making goldenrod a vital late-season food

Through the fall, the queen lays eggs that will become winter bees. These bees have a different physiology-they are fatter bees, capable of living up to six months versus 45 days like the typical worker bees. Their job is to generate heat to keep the area around the queen at the necessary 90-95 degrees.

Honeybees don't hibernate-they cluster. They form a ball of solid bees around the queen to keep her at a constant 90-95 degrees. They don't heat the whole hive, just the area of the cluster. As they need food, they will work the cluster through the hive. However, if the honey stores are just out of reach, the colony may starve rather than break formation and risk the queen's safety.

Honeybees generate their own water to drink through the winter. The heat generated inside creates condensation against the cold walls of the hive, giving them a source of moisture to drink.

Bees poop! On warmer winter days, honeybees will do "cleansing" flights to relieve themselves outside the hive. Have you ever noticed little yellow dots on your car? Yep, bee poop! Bees will not poop in the hive.
