

SIGNS OF SPRING:

March doesn't arrive with a grand announcement. It slips in quietly with longer evenings, softer light, a hint of green just beginning to show. It's a season of in-between, and vintage décor understands that space better than anything else.

Rather than rushing into full spring, this is the moment to make small, thoughtful changes that reflect the shift happening outdoors. With antiques and vintage pieces, those changes feel effortless, timeless and rooted in nature.

Nature, Gently Introduced

Spring décor doesn't have to mean bright colors or bold patterns. In March, it's often the simplest nods to nature that feel most refreshing.

Botanical artwork, pressed flowers, landscape scenes and garden-inspired pieces bring the outdoors in without overwhelming a space.

Vintage botanicals are especially appealing this time of year. Their soft tones and hand-drawn details feel calm and collected, echoing early spring rather than full bloom.

Greenery with History

Fresh greenery is one of the easiest ways to welcome spring, and vintage containers make it even better. Crocks, pitchers, stoneware bowls, iron planters and old baskets add texture and age to even the simplest stems. March greenery doesn't need to be dramatic. Branches, herbs or early seasonal greens feel more authentic than

full arrangements, and they transition beautifully from winter whites into spring.

Light Woods, Earthy Neutrals

As winter layers start to lift, natural materials take center stage. Light wood furniture, woven elements and pottery in soft neutrals add warmth without heaviness. These pieces reflect the season's shift toward simplicity and openness.

Timeworn finishes, chippy paint and gentle patina fit right in here. Spring isn't about perfection—it's about renewal, and pieces that show their age often feel the most alive.

Florals That Last

Not all spring flowers need watering. Floral motifs have been part of decorative arts for centu-

ries, and vintage florals offer a quieter alternative to fresh blooms. Transferware, embroidered linens, painted furniture and framed prints all carry floral elements that feel seasonally right without being temporary. These details work especially well in spaces already styled with neutral or winter décor, making the

transition seamless.

A Season That Unfolds Slowly

March reminds us that spring doesn't need to be rushed. With vintage décor, the change of seasons can be subtle—more felt than seen. A botanical print here, a crock of greenery there, a piece with natural texture brought forward from storage. These

small shifts signal what's coming while honoring the season you're still in. And that's the beauty of decorating with antiques: they move with time, not against it.





FOR THE LOVE OF COPPER

With the curtain call for the U.S. penny, it seems like a good time to delve into the world of metals, starting with copper. Since antiquity, several metals have been mined, melted and made into a variety of tools, vessels and decorative pieces. One of the “lesser” metals, copper is also one that has been used the longest. Sometime around the Bronze Age, mankind learned to mix this soft, malleable metal with tin to create an alloy that was both durable and a good conductor of heat (and, much later, electricity).

Copper has been mined nearly everywhere—from North America to Serbia and Israel, to name just a few of the better-known regions with abundant deposits.


Even though copper is a relatively inexpensive metal, it is a micronutrient necessary for humans (possibly even having anti-aging and cancer-fighting abilities), and it has long been known to have antimicrobial qualities, making it useful for purifying water stored in copper vessels.

Fast forward from 9,000 BC to 3,000 BC, and we find copper used for roofing, thanks to its anti-corrosive qualities. Leap ahead again to the 15th and 16th centuries, when the introduction of the printing press led to the use of engraved copper sheets for printing plates. The first official coin using copper was likely designed by Benjamin Franklin in 1787 and is known as the Fugio (Latin for “I fly”) cent. It was intended to counteract the problem of counterfeits and inconsistencies in the weight of coins printed by the thirteen original colonies. The Fugio cent is engraved with the phrase “Mind Your Business”—which Franklin meant as a reminder for business owners to literally take care of their businesses.

Given our phasing out of pennies, it is ironic that the original minted pennies (fewer than 4,000 are known to exist) are worth as much as \$10,000—certainly worth a lot more than “a penny for your thoughts” or even weighing in with your “two cents’ worth” on any subject.

Copper in the Kitchen

In the Victorian era, as tea became an affordable drink for the working class as well as the upper class, the humble copper kettle became a household staple for boiling water. Copper pots and pans date back to BCE, but we can thank the Romans for creating the “patella”—copper frying pans. The French later perfected copper cookware, which is still favored by professional and home chefs for its precise heating qualities, especially when creating delicate sauces. Where would many of our kitchens be without a gleaming rack of copper pots and pans behind the stove, blending



beauty and efficiency in our spaces?

Copper in the Bath and Laundry

Copper bathtubs have been around since the beginnings of recorded history and continued to be favored in the Renaissance and Medieval periods by those who could afford them. Their antimicrobial and heat-retention qualities made them the preferred bathing basin among the elite then—and even now.

Antique copper wash

kettles are also much sought-after, especially if they are in good shape and still have their original lids. As with bathtubs, these kettles held in heat and—whether we knew it or not—helped sanitize the water and laundry contained in them.

Copper as Jewelry

Many people shy away from copper jewelry because copper reacts with your skin’s chlorides, sulfides, sulfates and carbonates—and will probably turn your skin green over time. On the other hand, copper is suggested to have healing properties, including increased circulation and relief from joint pain, as well as assisting with better relaxation and sleep. Wearing copper jewelry is a bit of a trade-off of sorts.

Copper in Medicine

Aside from the purported benefits of preventing cancer and even Alzheimer’s, the medical field routinely relies on copper in many common products, including hip replacements, dental implants and vascular stents.

Where to Find Copper Pieces

As with most vintage and antique items, copper can be found in the usual haunts: estate sales, antique shops and flea markets. I found my own set of new/old stock Revere pans on a recent picking trip. They still had their original tags—which is a shame, because they cook beautifully, and it’s sad to think someone never dared to use them. (It’s also a little sobering to realize they are 50 years old this year.)

Caring for Copper

Polishing copper is relatively easy. Use a non-abrasive cleanser like Wright’s or Barkeeper’s Friend (test first if you suspect yours is not pure copper), or a wedge of juicy lemon and salt, and polish gently with a soft cloth. To maintain copper, wash with soap and water, and dry thoroughly to prevent water spots.

So even if we have to round up or down at the checkout counter as pennies fade from use, copper continues to play an important role in our everyday lives... and we hope you’ll find a way to use a few pieces in your home.





hang next to creamy ironstone. A hand-painted floral plate could sit beside sturdy restaurant ware. Small bread plates can balance larger serving pieces.

In Southern homes especially, this approach feels natural. Family heirlooms often play a starring role — a grandmother's china plate, an inherited platter or a piece saved from a loved one's collection. When paired with plates discovered at vendor markets, antique fairs or estate sales, the wall becomes a visual story of both heritage and adventure.

What to Look for While You Shop

Vendor markets and antique fairs are ideal places to build a plate wall. You're not searching for perfection — you're searching for pieces with character.

Keep an eye out for:

- Blue and white transferware in varying patterns
- Ironstone and whiteware with subtle texture or age
- Hand-painted floral or folk-art plates
- Restaurant ware with simple lines
- Souvenir or commemorative plates with regional charm

Don't shy away from signs of wear. Light crazing, soft edges or small imperfections add authenticity and warmth. These are details that make a plate wall feel lived-in and loved.

The Perfect Backdrop for Warm Neutrals

Plate walls pair beautifully with the rich, warm neutrals currently trending in home decor. Creamy whites, soft taupes, deep greens and warm browns create the ideal backdrop for vintage plates to shine.

White ironstone stands out against darker walls, while patterned plates add interest to lighter

spaces. Even a mostly neutral plate wall can bring texture and depth without overpowering a room, making it a simple way to refresh a space without a major overhaul.

Easy Ways to Create a Plate Wall

Building a plate wall doesn't have to be intimidating. A few simple tips can help keep the process enjoyable:

- Start with a loose color story rather than a strict pattern
- Mix plate sizes for balance and movement
- Lay plates out on the floor or trace them on paper before hanging
- Use plate hangers so pieces can be easily swapped or adjusted
- Add over time — the best plate walls grow naturally

There's no rush. Part of the charm is letting the wall evolve as new pieces are discovered.

A Trend Rooted in Story

Perhaps the reason plate walls feel so relevant right now is because they honor what many of us value most: history, craftsmanship and meaningful connections. They allow family heirlooms to live alongside flea-market finds and antique fair treasures, blending sentiment with style.

In choosing a collected, not matched approach, homeowners are embracing imperfection and personality over rigid rules. Each plate adds another layer to the story — one that continues every time you stroll through a vendor market or spot a piece that feels like it belongs.

As trends shift and styles change, the plate wall endures. Not because it's fashionable, but because it's personal. And that never goes out of style.







That mustard-and-mayo slaw you'll find piled high on hot



WHAT'S THE BUZZ ABOUT BEES?

March is an exciting time for beekeepers! The days are warming up and the bees are getting active again. The forager bees are out looking for pollen, as the queen has begun laying eggs again. The babies will be fed "bee bread," which is a mixture of honey and pollen. It is the perfect blend of carbohydrates and protein.

This is a crucial time for beekeepers to ensure there is enough food for the bees. If the bees have eaten through their honey stores, the beekeeper will have to feed them a 1:1 sugar water blend. With the increased activity and lack of available nectar, this time of year puts the bees at the greatest risk of the colony starving.

Fun fact: bees prefer fresh nectar to honey or sugar water.

As we proceed into the middle of March, the beekeeper's job changes from keeping the bees alive and fed to weekly inspections to prevent the hives from swarming. The queen will




begin to lay from 1,500-2,000 eggs a day. The colony's natural instinct is to swarm, which splits the hive, the natural process used to perpetuate the species. If the colony feels they are too big for the space they have, this will speed up their efforts to swarm.

Fun fact: a swarm of bees will not attempt to sting or harm you. As they are swarming, they don't have anything to protect, so they are not in fight mode.

If you live near an apiary, keep an eye on the hives. You can watch the boxes stack up as the colony grows and the honey fills them. Spring is near and it is the honey bee's time to shine! If you are interested in becoming a beekeeper, look for your local bee club and attend some meetings. Bee clubs offer free education and will assign a mentor to help you get started.

Beekeeping is very exciting and rewarding. We need more beekeepers. Give it a try!


