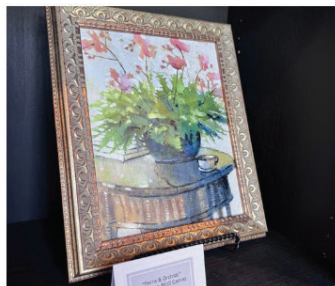

Angel Biscuits



- 5 c all purpose flour
- 3 T sugar
- 3 t baking powder
- 1 t soda • 1 t salt
- ¾ c shortening
- 1 package dry yeast
- ½ c warm water 105 to 115 degrees
- 2 c buttermilk

Combine flour, sugar, baking powder, soda and salt. Cut in shortening. Dissolve yeast in warm water. Stir into buttermilk. Add buttermilk mixture to dry ingredients and stir until moistened. Cover and chill.

When ready to use, roll out dough on lightly floured surface to ½ to ¾ inch thickness.

Cut out biscuits with 2-inch cutter and place on lightly greased cookie sheet.

Bake at 400° for 12 minutes. Dough will keep several weeks in the refrigerator.

FOR THE LOVE OF VINTAGE OUTDOOR FURNITURE

Do you love wrought iron settees and tables? Or maybe you hanker for a metal glider or rocker like you sat in as a kid at your grandparents' home. Even concrete statues and wicker planters from days gone by can add a touch of unique style and grace to your outdoor living space. Here's a quick rundown of what to look for when shopping for vintage outdoor pieces, and how to care for them to prolong their life.

Vintage outdoor furniture and planters bring back memories of lazy, hazy days of spring and summer. Whether your fondest outdoor memories were formed on a front porch or back porch (or somewhere else), the creak of a glider or porch swing can instantly take you back there. The best thing about vintage wicker, wrought iron benches, hardwood rockers and porch swings—even those metal gliders and chairs—is this: unless they've been completely neglected and abandoned to the elements, they've likely withstood the test of time and nature. With a little TLC, they can be restored to their former glory.

Wrought iron and metal furniture might have layers of chipping, peeling paint or rusted spots. When you're buying pieces, make sure the rust has not gone all the way through the piece, unless you have access to a metal fabricator who can repair it for you. Surface rust is a common problem on wrought iron or steel pieces, but if it's just on the surface, you can sand it smooth and repaint.

If you're looking at one or more layers of paint before you get to bare metal or wood, use some common-sense caution. Lead-based paints are very common, especially on outdoor surfaces. If you suspect lead-based paint, take extra precautions. Avoid dry sanding, wear a NIOSH-approved respirator and work in a well-ventilated outdoor area. Consider using wet sanding or appropriate stripping products to minimize dust, and always clean thoroughly after your project.

Hardwood rockers and porch swings are also likely to have several layers of old paint. A soy-based stripper can be a good tool in your arsenal to get your wood piece ready to repaint. Sandpaper (by hand or with a sander) can smooth splinters on bare wood.

When buying, make sure the wood is in good shape—feel and poke around with your fingernail; rot is easy to detect. If there are a few small rotten or soft spots, you can use a wood hardener on those areas. For more extensive rot, be prepared to replace entire slats or pieces to make the item structurally sound.



but it's probably the most fragile material you'll encounter. Gently loosen dirt and flaking paint with a soft- to medium-bristle nylon brush and warm water mixed with a little Dawn or another degreasing detergent. Rinse with a gentle stream of water—no pressure washing!

Once your piece is ready to paint, you'll need to choose how to refresh it. Wrought iron and other metal pieces can be powder-coated for the longest-lasting finish. Check with local businesses and get quotes. If that's not in your budget, the next best option is a high-quality spray paint. Follow the can's directions and apply thin coats, plus a sealer.

For wood and wicker pieces, you can use enamel spray paint or opt for chalk or milk paint. These are also rated for outdoor use and often have UV- and water-resistant properties. Follow directions for application, allow proper curing time and for extra protection, seal with a brush-on or spray-on sealer.

Then... sit back and enjoy your furniture and make some new memories this summer. Iced tea always tastes sweetest when it's enjoyed on a shady porch with a fragrant vine blooming nearby, doesn't it?

WHAT'S THE BUZZ ABOUT BEES?

It's Honey Time!

It's honey time! The flowers are blooming, the bees are flying and the nectar is flowing! Beekeepers are stacking up the honey supers on top of the hives to give the bees more room to store honey. The forager bees are out, flying up to 5 miles away from their homes to load up with nectar. They bring it back to the hive and pass it from their honey stomach to the nurse bees in the hive. The nurse bees then move the honey



Expect Natural Variation

Real local honey can change color (light to dark, depending on flowers) and crystallize over time—this is normal! Mass-produced honey tends to look the same year-round.

Local Honey Is from Local Flora!

If you don't have large orange groves where you live, "orange blossom" honey isn't local. If someone is selling multiple types (flavors) of honey, question where it came from. It may still be real, but is it really local?

Real Honey Isn't Cheap

& Cheap Honey Isn't Real!

Don't always look for the best deal when buying honey. Look for a beekeeper in your area.

Beekeepers work in difficult conditions—the heat of the sun, in a hot bee suit, regularly inspecting the health of the hive and lifting hive boxes that can weigh more than 50 pounds each.

Farmers markets are filled with honey sellers. Look for honey from your area. Do the plants and trees match what grows in your area?

up through the hive to store it where it is needed.

Some will be left in the bottom boxes, where the queen has laid eggs, using the honey to feed the babies. Some makes its way all the way to the top boxes, where it is stored.

The higher the hive, the more honey it's holding!

Fun Fact: What is a honeybee's favorite food? Not honey! Their favorite food is fresh nectar and pollen. Honey is stored for emergency backup—it is not their first choice!

How to Buy Real Honey

The bees are doing their work, the beekeeper is doing theirs and farmers markets are filling up with people selling honey. But how do you know you are getting real honey?

Read the Label Carefully

Be cautious of "Distributed by" or "Packed for"—these are often mass-produced and shipped in. A real local jar will often list a specific town or region, not just a company name. True local honey comes from bees within your local area (usually within ~50 miles).

Buy Direct When Possible

Farmers markets, roadside stands, local

beekeepers and small shops that source nearby. Bonus: You can often talk to the beekeeper and ask questions!

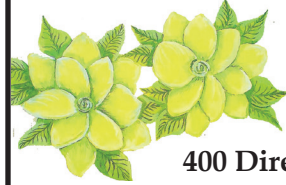

5 egg yolks
4 c sifted flour
1 t baking soda
1 T thick sour cream
Beaten egg
Cinnamon

Cream sugar and butter; add egg yolks and beat well. Add half the flour a little at a time; add soda mixed with sour cream. Add remaining flour and blend well. Place in refrigerator for about 1 hour. Roll and cut.

Brush tops of cookies with beaten egg; sprinkle with cinnamon and additional sugar.
Yield: 6 dozen cookies.
