VINTAGE RECIPE: Deviled Crab



- 1 lb crab meat, fresh
- 2 T chopped onion
- 2 T melted fat or oil
- 2 T flour
- ¾ c milk
- 1 T lemon juice
- 1½ t powdered mustard
- 1 t Worcestershire sauce
- ½ t salt
- 3 drops hot pepper sauce
- Dash pepper
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1 T chopped parsley
- ¼ c breadcrumbs

Sauté onion in fat until tender. Blend in flour. Add milk gradually and cook until thick, stirring constantly. Add lemon juice and seasoning to crab meat. Stir in hot sauce and egg. Add remaining ingredients and blend well. Place in 6 well-greased custard cups and sprinkle with breadcrumbs. Bake in a 350-degree oven for 25 minutes.

Yield: 6 servings.

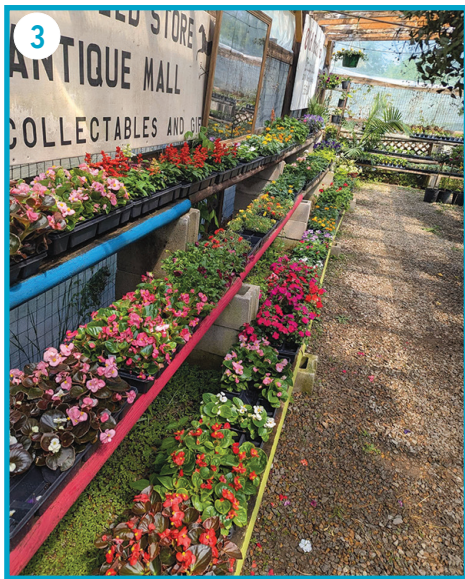

FOR THE LOVE OF JADITE (OR IS IT JADEITE?)

Milk glass—translucent, milky white glassware popularized in the late 19th century Victorian era—has some colorful cousins, including jadite, delphite, azurite and roseite: green, shades of blue and pink, respectively.

Even though milk glass in other hues (even black) is more rare, it's the most common green milk glass that is most popular. Kermit the Frog was wrong: apparently, it is easy being green.

Green milk glass was first introduced by McKee Glass in 1930, and they originally called it “Skokie” green. They offered a complete line of dinnerware, as well as accessories including salt and pepper shakers, juicer/reamers, mixing bowl sets, canisters and numerous other pieces.

Jeannette Glass, a competing manufacturer, began offering their own line of “Jadite” dishes in 1932, focusing mainly on mixing bowls, canisters, shakers and other kitchenware.

Over a decade passed before Anchor-Hocking/Fire-King introduced their own line of green glass dishes for commercial restaurant use, including divided plates, bowls, coffee cups and saucers and mugs in the mid-40s, which they called “Jade-ite.” In 1950, they added other items such as vases, mixing bowls and batter bowls with spouts and handles, and continued producing their line until the mid-1970s.

These durable, heat-proof, stain-proof kitchen and restaurant pieces might have faded away from popularity entirely, but Martha Stewart rekindled a love for collecting them when viewers saw her collection in articles and on air in the 1990s. (The real credit should go to Martha's daughter Alexis, who was the original collector, and many of her pieces found their way home between moves.) Suddenly, the once-forgotten and cast-off dishes became sought-after and beloved by another generation.

And that love affair hasn't abated. Fortunately for jadite fans, companies such as Mosser have continued to produce jade-green dishware. Martha Stewart has her own



in antique stores on certain jadite pieces, but do your research before you buy; only the rarest pieces command \$1,000 or more among collectors.

Age isn't the only factor when it comes to prized pieces. For example, a jade Santa Claus cookie jar was briefly sold at Cracker Barrel a few years ago. Its relative scarcity and nostalgia combine to drive the price north of \$500.

WHERE TO FIND JADITE?

As with most vintage and antique items, older jadite is most commonly found at estate sales, antique stores and online platforms such as eBay and Etsy. But do your homework and know the markings, the pieces originally offered and other “tells” before assuming it's true vintage.

If the tag doesn't specify whether it's new or older, a good clue is the number of similar pieces offered. Most vintage pieces are not found in abundance unless they are part

of a serious collection; however, wholesale sources often offer multiple reproduction pieces to their buyers, and you may spot a massive display in an antique mall. It may make your heart skip a beat, but inspect carefully so you know what you're buying.

HOW TO CARE FOR JADITE?

Handwashing is always best for vintage and antique glassware to avoid etching and discoloration; the same holds true for jadite, even though part of its appeal was its rugged durability.

HOW TO USE JADITE?

A collection of jadite always makes a stunning display. However, a few pieces can be mixed in with other dishware to add a pop of color and whimsy to a table setting or display cabinet. Be aware that some pieces may not be food-safe; do your research before using them on your table or as storage and mixing pieces.

branded line, as does Pioneer Woman.

Collectors can continue to acquire new additions to expand their collections, which can be fairly easily distinguished from midcentury pieces (and are clearly marked as such by reputable sellers). Additionally, authentic vintage jadeite pieces typically glow under a UV light due to their uranium content.

WHY IS IT CALLED JADITE?

AND IS THAT THE CORRECT SPELLING?

The answer is simple: after Jeannette introduced their dishware as “Jadite,” the name resonated with customers, who associated it with the same green as the semi-precious jadeite stone. It quickly became the household name for all the green glass produced, even though Anchor-Hocking used a different spelling (“Jade-ite”) to differentiate and trademark their line.

WHAT IS THE MOST RARE/VALUABLE JADITE?

Most collectors seek very specific pieces, many of which have advertising printed on them, as well as complete canister sets (with lids), which rarely survived the decades intact and unchipped or cracked. You may find some sky-high prices on eBay and

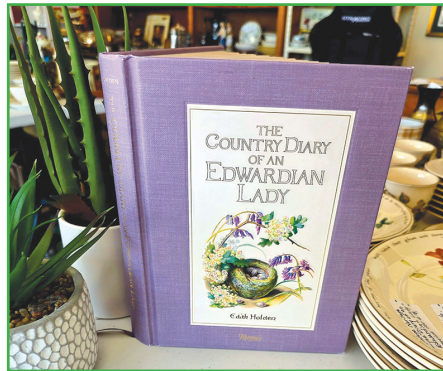

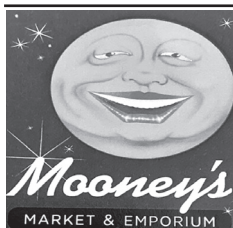

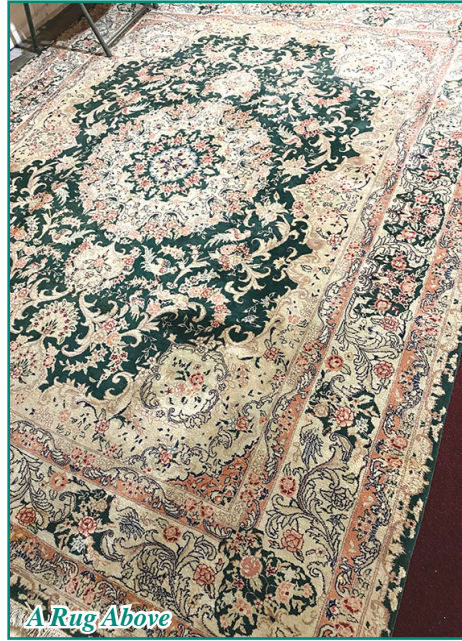

WHAT'S THE BUZZ ABOUT BEES?

The Dearth!

Definition: an inadequate supply, scarcity or lack of something.

June brings one of the hardest times of the year for honeybees. Nectar resources are winding down, if not completely gone, and there is a real lack of water. Most beekeepers have pulled the excess honey, which could otherwise be used by the bees to make up for the lack of nectar.

As you drive by beehives, you will notice them shrinking from multiple boxes high to only two or three. The boxes above the main brood chambers were filled with delicious honey. When the honey is gone, beekeepers may feed their bees a blend of sugar water during the summer. A responsible beekeeper will never feed their bees while the honey supers (boxes that hold the honeycombs) are on, as it may taint the honey with sugar water.

Water sources become incredibly important during the summer months. Bees need water to survive, as well as to cool down



their hives. Bees carry the water back to the hive in their honey stomachs, much like they do nectar. They place water throughout the hive on the comb edges, hive walls and surface of the brood (baby bee cocoons in the comb). House bees line up and rapidly fan their wings. This creates the same effect as an evaporative cooler. Maintaining the hive at a constant 93–95 degrees is imperative to keep the brood healthy, the wax sturdy and the stored honey from becoming runny.

You can help!!

Place shallow water stations for the bees! Use a Frisbee with rocks and twigs for them to land on. Place some twigs in your birdbath or even buy creative water stations. If you see a bee struggling, offer her a drink by placing a few drops of water or a little sugar water nearby to help get her home!

Together, we can save the bees!
